

Life Group Questions

(Genesis 33:1-20)

1. What happened when Jacob met Esau? In what ways does this passage illustrate God's sovereignty in the lives of individuals, even amidst conflict and history?
2. How can a person know if he's living by faith or by the flesh? What signposts can he look for?
3. Is spirituality an all-or-nothing matter or a progressive matter?
4. What are your spiritual weaknesses, that you are particularly prone to fall into, especially in times of difficulty? How do you protect yourself from falling into those weaknesses?
5. Why is our fellowship with God and our fellowship with other brothers and sisters in Christ so closely interrelated? (See 1John 4:20; Matthew 5:23-24).
6. How should we resolve our problems and conflicts with other people?
7. Are there any areas of delayed or partial obedience in your life? How is God calling you to remedy them? What are your fears that threaten your reception of God's promises and keep you from obedience? How can we further develop our faith?
